

Wastes Charges

All non-recyclable waste and large van/trailer loads of materials for recycling have to be taken to **Camalough, Kilkeel or Aughnagun Household Recycling Centre** and charges will apply.

We charge for:

- Any non-recyclable waste material from a trade/commercial source
- Large van/trailer loads of businesses waste for recycling
- Farm Waste
- Any waste from a builder or trade person's daily work
- Waste from commercial premises including:
 - Offices/Showrooms
 - Hotels/Bed & Breakfasts
 - Premises that keep or sell food
 - Premises used for trade or business
 - Pub Premises; and
 - Housing providers

The Council will however **accept for free** up to a small van/trailer of materials **that are fully sorted for recycling** from commercial premises at all HRCs. Height Barriers are in operation at Newry, Newtownhamilton and Warrenpoint.

Recycling your waste:

- Reduces the need for landfill
- Saves money

Household Recycling Centres

(HRCs)

Newry and Mourne District Council are making changes to the operational arrangements at the 7 Civic Amenity Sites from the 5th July and will be enforcing them from the 2nd August 2010.

These changes will include:

- Making sure you sort your waste properly and that you do not put recyclable materials in the general waste skips
- a new name- the sites will now be known as Household Recycling Centres
- An extra attendant at peak times at busy sites
- Height barriers at some sites
- Restrictions on which sites take commercial and trade waste
- New opening hours.

These important changes will help us reach our target to reduce waste going to landfill from these sites by 40% to 6,000 tonnes per year. At the moment it is costing ratepayers £730,000 per year to landfill this waste.

How will these changes affect you as a commercial/trade customer?

We know that our HRCs have an important role in helping to provide accessible recycling and disposal facilities for local businesses.

Therefore, car, small vans or small trailer loads of certain materials for recycling will be allowed at all centres **for free**.

However, unsorted waste and large van/ large trailer loads up to 1 tonne are accepted **ONLY** at Camlough, Kilkeel and Aughnagun HRCs and charges will apply.

Cars

Non-recyclable Waste Charges

£5.30—CLASS A— Car boot load (up to 50kgs) of non-recyclable waste once a day.

£26.30— CLASS B —Car load (over 50kgs) of non-recyclable waste once a day.

OR Recycling Charges

There is no charge for sorted recyclable materials in this category. One visit per day*

Small Vans / Trailers (single axle)

Non-recyclable Waste Charges

£26.30— CLASS B —non-recyclable waste once a day.

OR Recycling Charges

There is no charge for sorted recyclable materials in this category. One visit per day*

- * Cars/Small vans and small trailers of sorted recyclable material will be accepted at all HRCs once a day. Please be aware height barriers of 1.95m in operation at Newry, Warrenpoint and Newtownhamilton and unsorted waste will not be accepted in these sites.

Large Van / Twin axle trailer

Unsorted Waste Charges

£78.90 - CLASS C - Non-recyclable waste once a day.

OR Recycling Charges

There is a charge of £20 for sorted recyclable materials in this category. One visit per day.

HRCs Rules

- You must pay before disposal.
- Council customers must have their Recycling Pass with them.
- Please arrive with waste pre-sorted
- Please follow the direction of staff on site
- Please be aware any abusive customers will not be permitted on site and that CCTV can be used as evidence.
- You will be asked and challenged to recycle your waste

No Thanks

We will not accept the following materials as commercial or trade waste.

- Large loads over 1 tonne/lorries
- Paint or hazardous liquid wastes
- Fluorescent tubes/Batteries
- Trade electrical goods • Waste oil/Tyres

These materials are classed as hazardous waste and we are restricted in the types of materials we can accept from commercial/trade waste customers.

For a complete list, please visit our website. If you are unsure please contact us before travel.

Restrictions

- No Wheelie bins allowed for health and safety reasons.
- You must sort all your waste into recyclable and non-recyclable materials.
- Plasterboard is accepted at Aughnagun only and charges will apply.
- There are height barriers of 1.95m at the Newry, Warrenpoint, Newtownhamilton HRCs.
